STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)

1.0 Introduction

The Salt Lake Field Office (SLFO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) plans to contract the service for invasive weeds treatment in Tooele County Utah. The Tooele County Weeds Department was originally contracted to assist the BLM with invasive weed treatments on public lands as the county can better coordinate weeds treatments across multi-jurisdictional boundaries. The county weed department has unique local knowledge of the area and is located in close proximity to public lands in the county.

Several federal laws, regulations, and policies help to direct BLM in its management of invasive weeds on public lands. The proposed action to treat noxious weeds is consistent with the following regulations and policies.

1. Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976
2. Public Rangelands Improvement Act of 1978.
3. The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).
4. Executive Order 13112, Invasive Species.

And more specifically:

5. Carlson Foley act of 1968 and The Plant Protection act of 2000 (Public Law 106-224) which authorizes the BLM to coordinate with state and other agencies to control noxious weed species.
6. Federal Noxious Weeds Act of 1974, (as amended by Sec.15 – Management of Undesirable Plants on Federal Lands, 1990) establishes a noxious weed management program and implement cooperative agreements with the states.
7. Noxious Weed Control Act of 2004, requires the BLM to establish a program to provide assistance through weed management entities for the control or eradication of harmful and/or nonnative weeds on public and private lands.
8. Utah Noxious Weed Act, Rule R68-9 - designates the classes of noxious weeds for the State of Utah, and includes requirements for notifications and control.

2.0 Background

The BLM and SLFO have a long history of cooperation working with Tooele County and the State Department of Agriculture to manage invasive and noxious weeds. Tooele County and the SLFO have a signed agreement for the Squarrose Knapweed Cooperative Weed Management Area (CWMA) to provide funding and support. Funding for this action was previously provided through a cooperative agreement. The BLM's current preference for providing financial support is through contracts.

3.0 Objectives

To provide financial support to Tooele County, Utah to inventory and treat noxious weeds on BLM-managed public lands as required by federal law and policy.

4.0 Work Requirements

Approximately 300 acres would be inventoried and treated for noxious weeds on BLM-managed public lands in Tooele County, Utah.

5.0 Delivery

Tooele County shall deliver by the end of each period of performance to the BLM SLFO:

A **shapefile** (i.e., spatial geographic information system database) with infestation and treatment information. The information is subject to the following requirements:

Infestation information must contain sufficient information to be incorporated in the National Invasive Species Information Management System database. To be in compliance, the minimum information collected must include:

- A. Location: Latitude/Longitude or UTM coordinates collected with a GPS
- B. Weed Species: a) species name b) size of infestation

Treatment information must contain sufficient information to be incorporated in the National Invasive Species Information Management System database. To be in compliance, the minimum information collected must include:

- A. Location: Latitude/Longitude or UTM coordinates collected with a GPS
- B. Application: a) sprayer calibration b) spray acres c) mix amount applied on site
- C. Chemical: a) trade name b) common name c) rate of application
- D. Species Treated: a) species name b) size of infestation

6.0 Place of Performance

BLM-managed public lands in Tooele County, Utah.

7.0 Period of Performance

This contract covers Option Year 1 - August 15, 2018 through August 14, 2019.
