

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**Date:** November 2nd, 2018  
**Parties:** This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is made and entered into by and between Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) and Tooele County

**Purpose:** The purpose of the MOU is to serve as the understanding between the respective agencies with regard to delivery and acceptance of excavated earth materials not used on the project of approximately 100,000 yards will be delivered to Tooele County Solid Waste Management Yard (County Yard) without charge by UDOT's Contractor, for Tooele County to keep and use as needed.

**MOU term:** The MOU is effective on the date that it is signed by the respective authorized parties. The MOU shall remain in effect for the duration of the stated project. Afterwards the MOU can be terminated, modified or amended in writing by either party. Termination of the MOU, with or without cause, shall occur upon a 10 business-day written notice. Mutually agreeable amendments may be made between the parties, so long as the amendments are in writing.


**Terms:** UDOT's contractor, to be named at SR-179\_Midvalley Highway's award, shall haul up to 100,000 yards of excess excavated soil to Tooele County Yard at zero fee to UDOT's contractor. A soil report of expected material is attached for Tooele County's use.

**Professionalism and Civility:** To ensure the successful execution of this agreement UDOT will continue to communicate with professionalism and civility while working under this MOU. Nothing in this MOU is intended to deter, curtail or discourage communication between the respective agencies.
