

**RESOLUTION 2016-01**

**A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING PART OF THE COUNTY PURCHASING ORDINANCE FOR UMC**

**WHEREAS**, Tooele County is the owner of the racetrack facility known as Utah Motorsports Campus (“UMC”) which was formerly known as the Miller Motorsports Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Tooele County is preparing to sell the racetrack facility within the calendar year and desires that the racetrack facility remain open for the 2016 racing season; and

**WHEREAS**, Tooele County has contracted with Utah Motorsports Campus, Inc. (“Contractor”) to manage the racetrack facility because of its expertise in the motorsports industry; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tooele County purchasing ordinance was not written with the understanding that Tooele County would own the racetrack facility or have a company manage it; and

**WHEREAS**, Contractor is working under severe time constraints to prepare UMC for the 2016 racing season and must make numerous purchases.

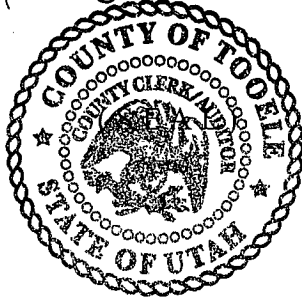
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the competitive bid requirements under Tooele County Code 1-8-3 are temporarily suspended for the purchases of all goods and services for UMC, except for the purchases of equipment, vehicles, improvements, and fixtures.
