

ORDINANCE 2005-17

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WORKERS'
COMPENSATION ACCIDENT BOARD**

WHEREAS, Tooele County is required by insurance best practices to establish a Workers' Compensation Accident Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - CHAPTER ENACTED. Tooele County Code Title 4 Chapter 15 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 15

WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACCIDENT BOARD

4-15-1. Board established.

4-15-2. Membership and terms.

4-15-3. Duties.

4-15-1. Board established.

There is hereby created the Tooele County Workers' Compensation Accident Board.

4-15-2. Membership and terms.

Workers' Compensation Accident Board members shall be appointed by the Tooele County Commission. Their terms will run indefinitely.

4-15-3. Duties.

The Workers' Compensation Accident Board shall meet on a regular basis, but not less than quarterly, unless there are no accidents to review; keep written minutes of each meeting and forward a copy of the minutes to the Workers' Compensation Loss Control Manager; review all accidents that involve personal injury to county employees or volunteers, or that involve claims that have been reported to the county's Workers' Compensation loss carrier; and send copies of the accident reviews or reports to such carrier.



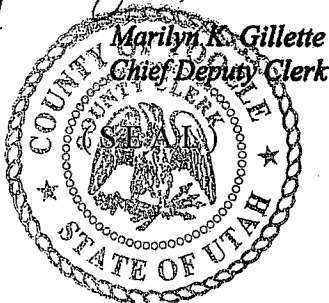


