ORDINANCE 2017-03

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TERM LIMITATIONS, OF TITLE 4, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES, OF THE TOOELE COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission desires to establish a beginning date and ending date for all terms on County boards and committees. All terms will begin on January 1 and end on December 31 of the last year of a member's term. The amendment will also allow a member to continue to serve at the end of their term until a successor is elected or appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – CHAPTER RENAMED. Chapter 3, *Term Limitations*, of Title 4, *Boards and Committees*, of the Tooele County Code is hereby renamed to *Terms*.

SECTION II – **CHAPTER AMENDED.** Chapter 3, *Terms* (formerly *Term Limitations*), of Title 4, *Boards and Committees*, of the Tooele County Code is hereby amended to read as attached hereto, which attachment is, by this reference, made a part hereof.

SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.
