ORDINANCE 2017-16

AN ORDINANCE SEPARATING THE OFFICE OF CLERK/AUDITOR, FORMING THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK AND THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR

WHEREAS, in 2014 the Tooele County Commission passed Ordinance 2014-01 which consolidated the offices of the Clerk and Auditor to form the office of Clerk/Auditor. There is now a desire to separate the Clerk/Auditor Office into two separate offices once again.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – SEPARATION OF CLERK/AUDITOR OFFICE. Pursuant to §17-16-3 U.C.A., the Tooele County Commission hereby separates the office of Clerk/Auditor, along with all the respective duties for each office as outlined in Utah Code, to form the office of the Clerk and the office of the Auditor.

The separated offices of Clerk and Auditor will be elected during the 2018 election cycle and both will take office on Monday, January 7, 2019.

After the separation, all Tooele County Code references to Clerk/Auditor shall be deemed the same as Clerk or Auditor, as appropriate.

SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.
