NOTICE OF ELECTION

2020 REGULAR GENERAL ELECTION

I, Marilyn K. Gillette, Tooele County Clerk, in accordance with Utah Code Annotated §20A-5-101, do hereby notify the residents of Tooele County that:

1. attached is a list of the offices to be filled at the regular general election to be held in the State of Utah on Tuesday, November 3, 2020;
2. attached is a list of filing fees;
3. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates begins on Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2020;
4. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for local board of education candidates begins on Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March, 19, 2020;
5. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Wednesday, July 1, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2020;
6. the Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins on Thursday, January 2, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2020.
7. Qualified political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for the elective office.

1. FEDERAL

- a. **U.S. President and Vice President.** These positions will be elected for a four (4) year term.
- b. **U.S. House of Representatives.** One Representative for a two (2) year term in each of the following U.S. Congressional Districts:
 - i. Second District. The Second Congressional District consists of Beaver, part of Davis, Garfield, Iron, part of Juab, Kane, Millard, Piute, part of Salt Lake, part of Sanpete, Sevier, Tooele, Washington, and Wayne Counties.

2. STATE

- a. **State Executive.** The following positions will be elected for a four (4) year term:
 - i. Attorney General.
 - ii. Governor.
 - iii. Lieutenant Governor.
 - iv. State Auditor.
 - v. State Treasurer
- b. **State House of Representatives.** One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from each of the seventy-five (75) state legislative districts.
- c. **Local Boards of Education.** Members of the local boards of education should be elected as determined by individual school boards or districts.
 - i. District One (1) representing Tooele 17, 18, 19, 20, 21.
 - ii. District Two (2) representing Tooele 1,2,3,4,5,6 and 8
 - iii. District Three (3) representing Tooele 7,9,10,11,12 and Lincoln
 - iv. District Four (4) representing Tooele 13,14,15,16 and Erda 1.1

3. JUDICIAL

- a. **Supreme Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- b. **Court of Appeals.** There will be a retention election for six (6) Court of Appeals Judges, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- c. **District Court.** There will be a retention election for twenty-four (24) District Court Judges in the following districts, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period:
 - i. Third District. Five (5) Judges in the Third Judicial District, which consists of Salt Lake, Summit, and Tooele Counties.

- d. **Juvenile Court.** There will be a retention election for ten (10) Juvenile Court Judges in the following districts, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period:
 - i. Third District. Three (3) Judges in the Third Judicial District, which consists of Salt Lake, Summit, and Tooele Counties.
- e. **Justice Court.** Any Justice Court judge whose term is expiring shall be subject to an unopposed retention election in the county or counties in which the court to which the judge is appointed is located.

4. COUNTY

County offices up for election are to be determined by the county's form of government.

- a. **Tooele County Council District Seats** – Three County Council seats, each for a term of four (4) years.
 - i. District One (1) representing Tooele 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21
 - ii. District Three (3) representing Tooele 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, Erda 1.1, 2.1
 - iii. District Four (4) representing Stansbury Park, Lake Point, Erda 1.2, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4, Lincoln
- b. Other County Officials as applicable for each county.
 - i. Tooele County Assessor
 - ii. Tooele County Recorder/Surveyor
 - ii. Tooele County Treasurer
