



LEGEND

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS INUNDATED BY 100-YEAR FLOOD

- ZONE A** - 100-year flood elevation
- ZONE AE** - Flood depth of 1 to 3 feet (usually area of abandoned levee) from flood elevation
- ZONE AV** - Flood depth of 1 to 3 feet (usually area of flood depth, usually along right-of-way) from flood elevation
- ZONE AVB** - To be removed from 100-year flood by floodway area provisions
- ZONE V** - Coastal flood with velocity hazard
- ZONE VE** - Coastal flood with velocity hazard (storm surge) from flood elevation

FLOODWAY AREAS IN ZONE AE

- ZONE A** - Areas of 100-year flood, area of 100-year flood with average depth of 1 to 3 feet, or with floodway provisions

OTHER AREAS

- ZONE X** - Areas designated to be outside 100-year flood plain
- ZONE D** - Areas in which flood hazard is undetermined
