## **RESOLUTION 2001-6**

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE TOOELE COUNTY SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT; REPEALING RESOLUTION 82-5 WHICH HAD ESTABLISHED AN ADVISORY BOARD; APPOINTING THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE DISTRICT; AND REINVESTING ALL POWERS OF THE DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on December 18, 1979, there was established, pursuant to the Utah Special Service District Act, Chapter 23 of Title 11, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, a special service district denominated as "Tooele County Special Service District," which had the purpose of providing water and related services to the district; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 82-5 the county commission established an advisory board for the district and delegated to the board certain powers to govern; and

WHEREAS, the district has been inactive for several years and the county commission recognizes the need to activate the district to work on new projects;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Resolution 82-5, providing for the establishment of an advisory board as the governing authority of the Tooele County Special Service District, is hereby repealed. The advisory board is hereby dissolved and all power heretofore invested in it are reinvested in the Tooele County Commission.

Section 2: The Tooele County Commission is hereby appointed as the governing authority of the Tooele County Special Service District and is vested with all powers allowed by Utah Code Annotated, Section 17A-2-1301 et. seq.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


