RESOLUTION 2003-04

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS IN TOOELE COUNTY FOR AIRCRAFT LANDING AND TAKE OFF; AND AUTHORIZING A LANDING AND TAKE OFF PERMIT TO BE ISSUED TO BEEHIVE TELEPHONE

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. §72-10-117 (1) provides:

- (1) (a) The county executive of any county may issue permits authorizing aircraft to land on or take off from designated county roads.
 - (b) Permits may be issued to aircraft operated:
 - (i) as air ambulances;
 - (ii) as pesticide applicators; or
 - (iii) by or under contract with public utilities and used in connection with inspection, maintenance, installation, operation, construction, or repair of property owned or operated the public utility.

AND WHEREAS, Rule 914-2-2 of the Utah Administrative Code provides:

R914-2-2. Procedures

- A. Only lightly traveled roads will be used for aircraft operations. Counties will designate particular county road segments to be used.
- B. The road to be used for aircraft operations will be inspected by ground personnel for safety prior to use.
- C. The road segment to be used will be blocked off by ground personnel prior to aircraft operations to insure that there is no road traffic during the aircraft use period.
 - D. Landings will be permitted on roads during daylight hours only.

AND WHEREAS, Beehive Telephone has requested Tooele County designate portions of three county roads as places where their aircraft may be authorized to land or take off;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY THAT the portions of the three county roads as highlighted on the attached map are hereby designated as areas authorized to land aircraft and to allow their take-off. The county executive may issue a landing and take-off permit to Beehive Telephone inasmuch as their plane is used by a public utility in connection with inspection,

maintenance, installation, operation, construction, or repair of property owned or operated by the public utility.
