

RESOLUTION 2010-03

A RESOLUTION AMENDING PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES SUBSECTION 6.D.1 REGARDING APPOINTED EMPLOYEES, ADDING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AS A COUNTY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission finds it necessary to revise Personnel Polices and Procedures Subsection 6.D.1 due to the addition of Economic Development as a county department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION that Personnel Polices and Procedures Subsection 6.D.1 of Appointed Employees in Section 6, Employee Status, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The following employees are designated as appointed employees:
 - a. chief deputies and members of elected officials' personal staff;
 - b. members of policy, advisory, review, and appeal boards or similar bodies who do not perform administrative duties as individuals;
 - c. time-limited or contract positions established for the purpose of conducting special projects and programs;
 - d. department directors of aging, airport, building maintenance, economic development, emergency management, engineering, health, human resource management, information technology, parks and recreation, roads, solid waste management, and the airport manager;
 - e. the lieutenants in the sheriff's department; and
 - f. temporary, seasonal, on-call, and emergency employees.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution is effective retroactive to February 28, 2010.

D. APPOINTED EMPLOYEES:

1. The following employees are designated as appointed employees:
 - a. chief deputies and members of elected officials' personal staff;
 - b. members of policy, advisory, review, and appeal boards or similar bodies who do not perform administrative duties as individuals;
 - c. time-limited or contract positions established for the purpose of conducting special projects and programs;
 - d. department directors of aging, airport, building maintenance, economic development, emergency management, engineering, health, human resource management, information technology, parks and recreation, roads, solid waste management, ~~roads and shops~~, and the airport manager;
