A RESOLUTION PROVIDING NOTICE OF TOOELE COUNTY'S INTENT TO RAISE TAXES; THE COUNTY GENERAL LEVY WOULD BE INCREASED BY 5%, GENERATING \$311,000 IN ADDITIONAL REVENUE WHICH WILL BE USED TO PAY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT, ROAD PROJECTS, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND VOTING MACHINES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County, Utah, pursuant to UCA 59-2-919, hereby provides public notice of its intent to increase the County General Levy by 5%. This increase would generate an additional \$311,000 in property tax revenue which will be used to pay for law enforcement, road projects, community development, and voting machines.

If the proposed tax increase is approved, the County General Levy tax on a \$240,000 residence will increase from \$192.34 to \$203.22, which is \$10.90 per year, and the County General Levy tax on a \$240,000 business will increase from \$349.68 to \$369.49, which is \$19.81 per year.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase at the County Commission Meeting held on November 21, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in Room 321 of the Tooele County Building at 47 S. Main Street in Tooele, Utah.
