

RESOLUTION 2018-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN OPINION QUESTION TO BE INCLUDED ON THE BALLOT FOR THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION TO IMPOSE A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX OF ONE QUARTER OF ONE PERCENT (0.25%) TO FUND A SYSTEM FOR PUBLIC TRANSIT

WHEREAS, Section 59-12-2214, Utah Code Annotated, authorizes counties to impose a local sales and use tax of one quarter of one percent (0.25%) to fund a system for public transit within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission desires to improve public transit by implementing this sales and use tax, if a majority of voters are in favor of it; and

WHEREAS, UCA § 59-12-2208 requires the Tooele County Commission to publish notice of an opinion question on the General Election ballot regarding the proposed imposition of the local sales and use tax; and

WHEREAS, the opinion question must be submitted in the November 6, 2018 General Election held in Tooele County; and

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission has a duty to prescribe the form of the ballot and various other forms and General Election procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Tooele County Commission resolves as follows:

1. A notice of an opinion question to be placed on the General Election ballot shall be prepared and published for the purpose of authorizing the imposition of a local sales and use tax of one quarter of one percent (0.25%) to fund a system for public transit in Tooele County. Said notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Tooele County not less than 15 days before the election. The Notice shall be published in form and content as follows:

GENERAL ELECTION NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Tooele County Commission has called for an opinion question to be placed on the General Election ballot, for the purpose of authorizing the imposition of a local sales and use tax of one quarter of one percent (0.25%) to fund a system for public transit in Tooele County. Polling places, time, and election officials will be the same as already established by the Tooele County Clerk/Auditor for the General Election. All qualified voters shall be entitled to vote either for or against the proposal. The General Election will be held on the 6th day of November, 2018 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

END OF NOTICE

2. The Tooele County Commission hereby directs the Tooele County Clerk/Auditor and all other appropriate officers and employees of the County to take all actions necessary and appropriate to conduct the General Election specified herein and that the General Election be conducted in accordance with State law as to voting, registration, challenges to voters, judges, ballot forms, sample ballots, absentee voting, canvass, notice of results, and all other election procedures.

3. The ballot page layout shall be in a form prescribed by law and similar to that attached as Exhibit A.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

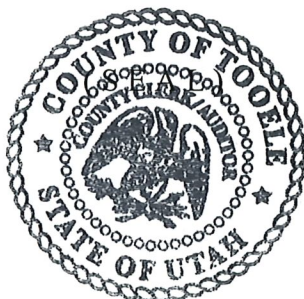
