

RESOLUTION 2018-12

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING NOTICE OF TOOELE COUNTY'S INTENT TO RAISE TAXES; THE COUNTY ASSESSING AND COLLECTING LEVY WOULD BE INCREASED BY 10%, GENERATING \$179,959 IN ADDITIONAL REVENUE WHICH WILL BE USED TO PAY FOR INCREASED ASSESSING AND COLLECTING COSTS, INFLATION, AND EMPLOYEE HEALTH COSTS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County, Utah, pursuant to UCA 59-2-919, hereby provides public notice of its intent to increase the County Assessing and Collecting Levy by 10%. This increase would generate an additional \$179,959 in property tax revenue which will be used to pay for increased assessing and collecting costs, inflation, and employee health costs.

If the proposed tax increase is approved, the County Assessing and Collecting Levy tax on a \$240,000 residence will increase from \$56.76 to \$62.44, which is \$5.68 per year, and the County Assessing and Collecting Levy tax on a \$240,000 business will increase from \$103.20 to \$113.52, which is \$10.32 per year.


All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase at the County Commission Meeting held on November 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in Room 321 of the Tooele County Building at 47 S. Main Street in Tooele, Utah.

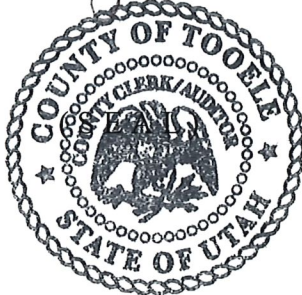
