

RESOLUTION 2018-14

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE RECERTIFICATION OF THE TOOELE COUNTY JUSTICE COURT

WHEREAS, the provisions of Utah Code Annotated 78A-7-103 require that Justice Courts be recertified at the end of each four-year term; and

WHEREAS, the present term of the Tooele County Justice Court shall expire in February of 2019; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Tooele County Commission have received an opinion letter from Scott Broadhead, County Attorney, which sets forth the requirements for the operation of a Justice Court and feasibility of continuing to maintain the same; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Tooele County Commission have determined that it is in the best interests of Tooele County to continue to provide for a Justice Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Tooele County Commission hereby requests recertification of the Tooele County Justice Court by the Board of Justice Court Judges and the Utah Judicial Council; and
2. The Tooele County Commission hereby affirms its willingness to continue to meet all requirements set forth by the Judicial Council for continued operation of the Tooele County Justice Court for the next four-year term of court, except as to any requirements waived by the Utah Judicial Council.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
