ORDINANCE 2003-09

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTERS 20 AND 21 OF THE UNIFORM ZONING ORDINANCE OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH REGARDING GROUP RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES FOR ELDERLY AND DISABLED PERSONS; AND REENACTING CHAPTER 20, RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES FOR ELDERLY AND DISABLED PERSONS

THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - REPEALER. Chapters 20 and 21 of the Uniform Zoning Ordinance of Tooele County are hereby repealed.

SECTION II - REENACTMENT. Chapter 20 of the Uniform Zoning ordinance of Tooele County is hereby reenacted to read as attached hereto, which attachment is, by this reference, made a part hereof.

SECTION III - GENERAL REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.
