**A RESOLUTION REPEALING SUBSECTION 27.G, DEPUTY SHERIFF  
RESIDENCY, OF SECTION 27, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, CORRECTIONS  
OFFICERS, COURT SECURITY, AND DISPATCH OFFICERS, OF THE  
PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL**

WHEREAS, the current recruiting market for law enforcement officers is challenging, and the County hopes to increase the number of applicants by removing the requirement to be a Tooele County resident.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION that Personnel Policies and Procedures Subsection 27.G, *Deputy Sheriff Residency*, of Section 27, *Deputy Sheriffs, Corrections Officers, Court Security, and Dispatch Officers*, is hereby repealed.


**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

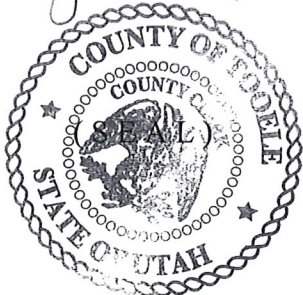

**G. DEPUTY SHERIFF RESIDENCY:**

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Sheriff may allow a deputy sheriff assigned to serve the Wendover area to live in Wendover, Nevada and to possess a Nevada driver's license so long as that deputy's POST certification is not canceled. All other deputy sheriffs shall be residents of Tooele County.
