TOOELE COUNTY ORDINANCE 2020-20

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 8-14, NUISANCE WEEDS, OF CHAPTER 8, NUISANCES, OF THE TOOELE COUNTY LAND USE ORDINANCE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – PURPOSE. Planning Staff has identified the need to have an ordinance to address nuisance weeds and to aid in fire breaks for larger properties.

The Tooele County Planning Commission held a public hearing and made a favorable recommendation to enact this section.

SECTION II – SECTION ENACTED. Section 8-14, *Nuisance Weeds*, of Chapter 8, *Nuisances*, of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8-14. Nuisance Weeds.

In order to help mitigate any fire hazard, reference will be made to Tooele County Land Use Code Chapter 21, Wildland/Urban Interface Overlay Zone (WUI), alongside this chapter and any person in violation of Chapter 21 will be referred to the proper authorities for that chapter's enforcement.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation owning, occupying, or otherwise exercising control over real property in Tooele County to allow, permit, cause, or maintain property with:
 - (a) Vegetation such as weeds and/or grass, unmanicured brush, and unmaintained landscaping in excess of 6 inches in height located:
 - (i) Within any public right-of-way between the property line and edge of street pavement;
 - (ii) On any parcel smaller than 1 acre;
 - (iii) On any parcel 1 acre or larger, within 30 feet of a property line and any habitable structure.

SECTION III – REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV – **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.
