RESOLUTION 2020-17**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING PUBLIC SAFETY, PUBLIC HEALTH,  
HEALTH CARE, HUMAN SERVICES, AND OTHER SIMILAR  
EMPLOYEE SERVICES AS SUBSTANTIALLY DEDICATED TO  
MITIGATING OR RESPONDING TO THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH  
EMERGENCY AS DETERMINED BY THE CARES ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed by the President on March 27, 2020 to provide emergency assistance and health care response for individuals, families, and businesses affected by the 2020 coronavirus pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, through the Coronavirus Relief Fund, the CARES Act provides for payments to State, Local, and Tribal governments navigating the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Treasury has made payments from the Fund to States and eligible units of local government, including Tooele County; and

**WHEREAS**, the CARES Act requires that the payments from the Coronavirus Relief Fund only be used to cover expenses that are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19.

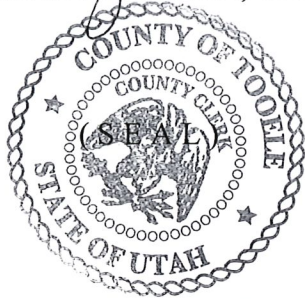


