

**TOOELE COUNTY
ORDINANCE 2019-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-12-1, PURPOSE, OF
CHAPTER 12, EMERGENCY INTERIM SUCCESSION PROCEDURES,
OF THE TOOELE COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission finds it necessary to update the Utah Code reference in Tooele County Code Section 1-12-1 which refers to the Emergency Interim Succession Act. The Act has been relocated in the Utah Code to Title 53, Chapter 2a, Part 8 since the County's last amendment to Section 1-12-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – SECTION AMENDED. Section 1-12-1, *Purpose*, of Chapter 12, *Emergency Interim Succession Procedures*, of the Tooele County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

This chapter is for the purpose of implementing the Emergency Interim Succession Act (Section 53-2a-801 et seq., Utah Code Annotated 1953) and providing for continuity in Tooele County Government operations and functions in times of a local emergency or disaster.

SECTION II – REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III – EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Tooele County Commission, which is the legislative body of Tooele County, passed, approved and enacted this ordinance this 29th day of October 2019.


