

ADDENDUM TO
TOOELE COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF RUSH VALLEY ROAD MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT
(CONTRACT NO. 89-03-05)

ADDENDUM dated this 15th day of September, 2020, between TOOELE COUNTY, a body politic and corporate of the State of Utah ("County"), and the TOWN OF RUSH VALLEY, a municipal corporation of the State of Utah ("Town").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated March 1, 1989 for the purpose of committing County resources to maintain certain roads within Town's geographical boundaries ("the 1989 Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the 1989 Agreement states that County shall have no responsibility to maintain, among other things, water crossings or culverts; and

WHEREAS, County is about to provide road maintenance required by the 1989 Agreement and the parties have discovered that several culverts under the roads to be maintained have become damaged over time; and

WHEREAS, County is able to immediately replace the culverts while providing the road maintenance required by the 1989 Agreement; and


WHEREAS, the cost to replace the damaged culverts is \$5,247.40; and

WHEREAS, Town is willing to pay to County the entire cost of replacing the damaged culverts;

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. While in the immediate process of providing road maintenance required by the 1989 Agreement, County shall replace the damaged culverts.
2. Town shall pay County \$5,247.40 within 90 days of the date of this Addendum.
3. This is a one-time accommodation only, and nothing in this Addendum shall otherwise alter or increase County's obligations under the 1989 Agreement.
