SURPLUS PROPERTY

- A) **FIFTH READING AND APPROVAL - THE WELL PARCEL IN SOUTH WILLOW ESTATES THAT GRANTSVILLE WANTS TO DRILL A WELL ON. PARCEL #15-088-0-000G.** Commissioner Tripp discussed this item. The value of this property, according to the Assessor's Office, is \$15,000. Grantsville has agreed to pay \$15,000 for this property. Tooele County recently borrowed a concrete zipper from Grantsville. The cost of renting the concrete zipper will be taken off the price of the well, about \$2,600. Commissioner Milne would feel more comfortable if they pay for the rental out of the Roads fund. Mayor Marshall asked to forget the \$2,600 for the zipper. They would like to get this project moving forward and are willing to pay the \$15,000. Commissioner Milne made a motion to pay the \$2,600 out of the Roads Department funds and let Grantsville City pay the \$15,000 for the well. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. All concurred.
