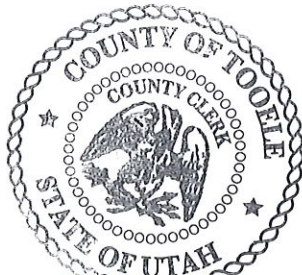

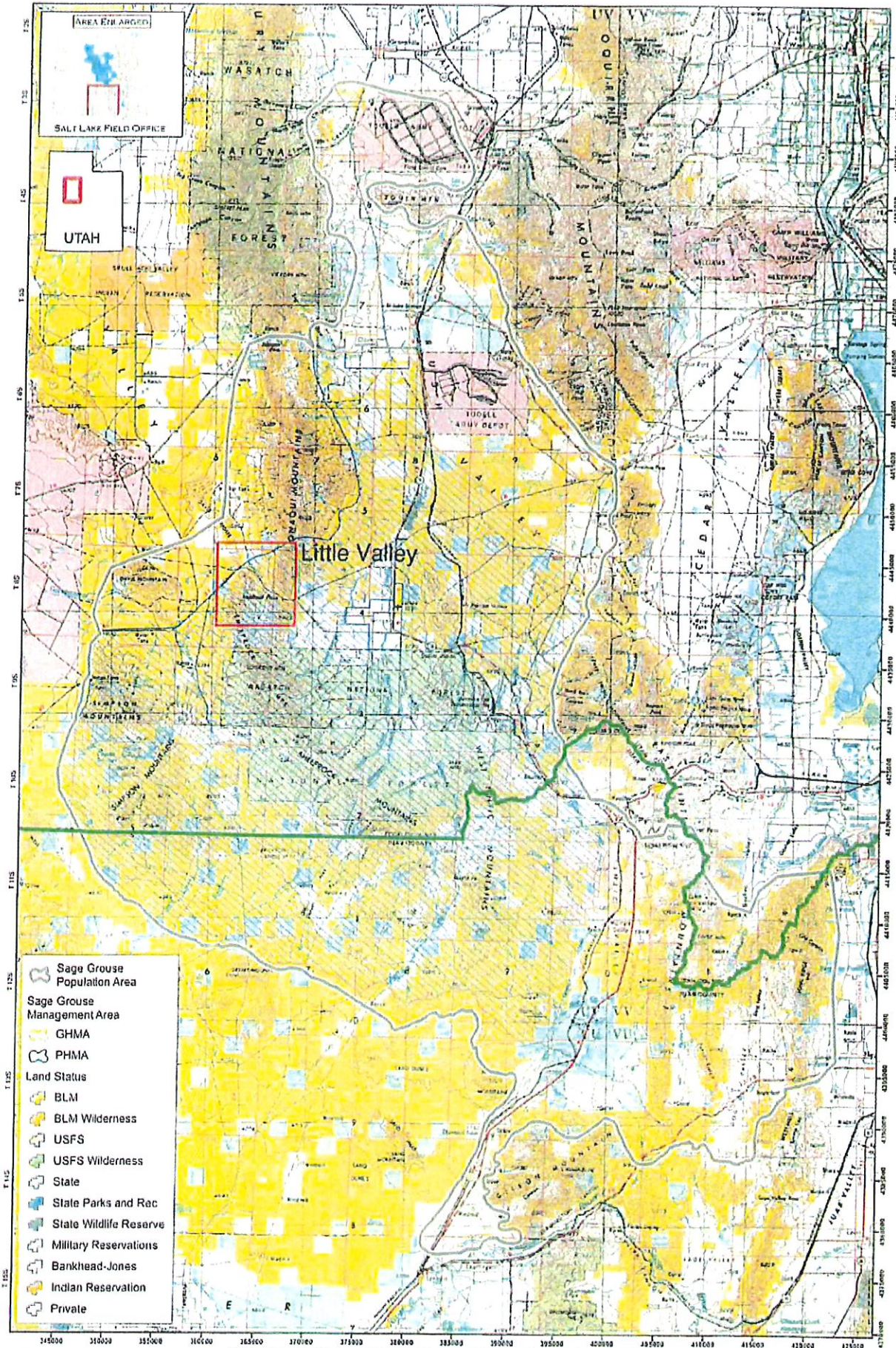

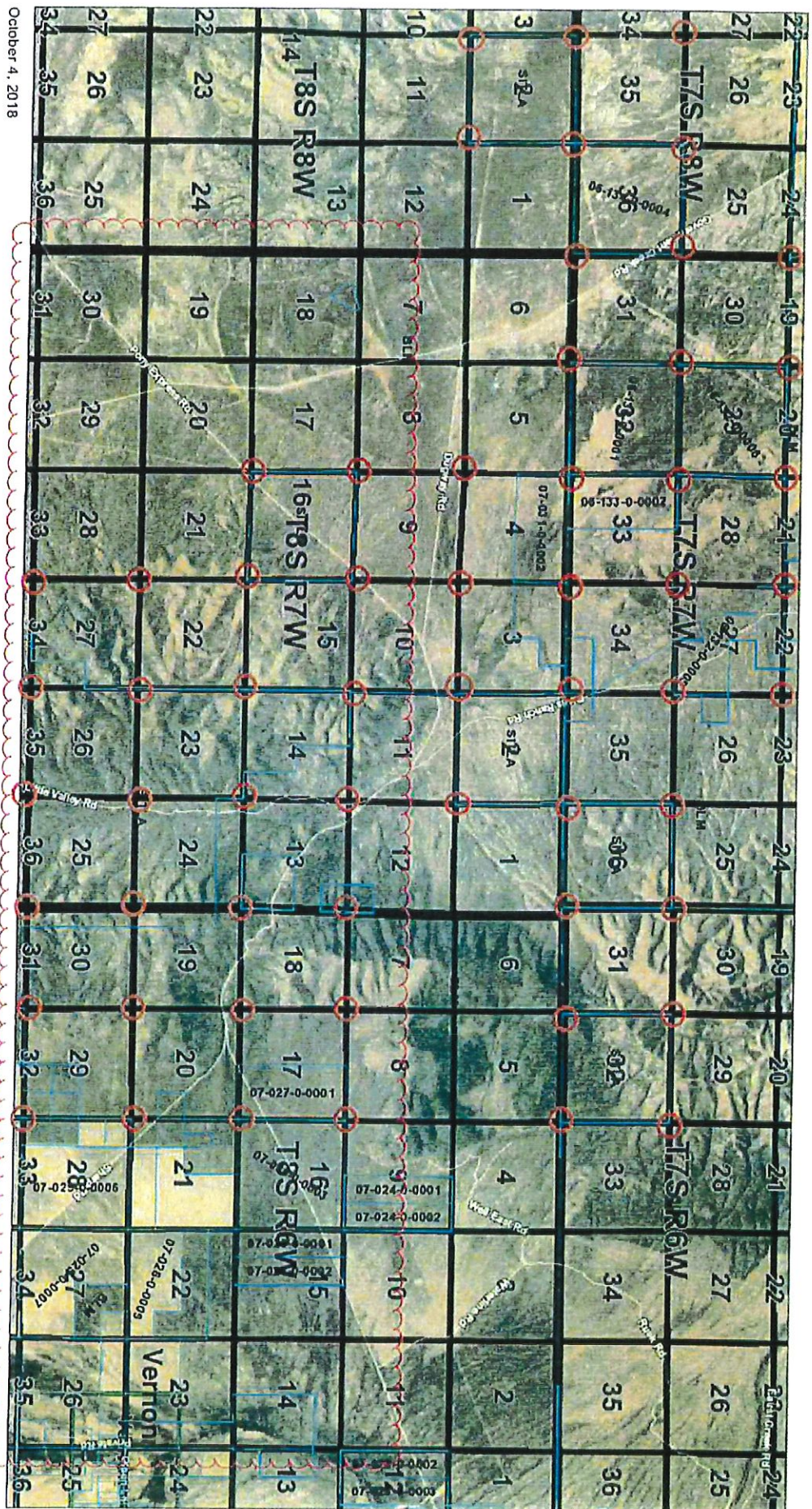
GREATER SHEEPOCKS SAGE GROUSE ANALYSIS

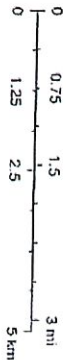
