

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION, NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING, AND NOTICE OF PROTEST PERIOD

The Tooele County Council has adopted a resolution stating its intent to annex the Stansbury Recreation Service Area and all cities and towns within the county into the Tooele County Recreation Special Service District. If the annexation occurs as proposed, the boundaries of the Tooele County Recreation Special Service District will be expanded to encompass all of Tooele County.

The Tooele County Recreation Special Service District receives mineral lease funds and distributes those funds to furnish recreation services and facilities. It does not impose or collect taxes, and it does not charge fees for its services.

The Tooele County Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on June 15, 2021, in Room 306 of the County Administration Building, 47 South Main Street, Tooele, Utah.

Anyone opposed to the proposed annexation may appear at the public hearing or may file a written protest with the Tooele County Council, 47 South Main Street, Tooele, Utah 84074. Written protests must be received on or before August 16, 2021 and must state the reason(s) for the opposition to the proposed annexation.
