The most current data published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Consumer Price Index for the Food Away From Home category shows an increase of 3.9% over the last year. As Trinity has not requested a price adjustment since April, 2018, we are requesting an increase of 3.9% effective April 1, 2021, to help us defer the increased cost of providing the meals over the past 24 months.
