

**TOOELE COUNTY
ORDINANCE 2021-23**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 5, GENERAL PLAN, OF
TITLE 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF THE TOOELE COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 5, General Plan, of Title 1, General Provisions, of the Tooele County Code contains only one section, Section 1-5-1; and

WHEREAS, Section 1-5-1 is a brief reference to the county's general plan; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3 of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance discusses the county's general plan in detail; and

WHEREAS, Section 1-5-1 is very similar to the introductory portion of Section 3-1(1) of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, provisions regarding the county's general plan are more appropriately located in the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – CHAPTER REPEALED. Chapter 5, *General Plan*, of Title 1, *General Provisions*, of the Tooele County Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION II – REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III – EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.



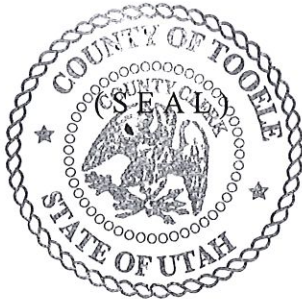
