A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY OFFICES TO BE CLOSED THE DAY AFTER THANKSGIVING EACH YEAR

WHEREAS, county officials have determined decided each year whether county offices should be open or closed the day after Thanksgiving; and

WHEREAS, the county wishes to create a standard practice so the public and employees can know in advance the status of county offices on that day; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated 17-16-9(2)(a) authorizes the county legislative body, by resolution, to determine when their offices shall be open for the transaction of business;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL that:

- 1. Tooele County administrative offices shall be closed the day after Thanksgiving.
- 2. Certain county offices may be open if required by law or if necessary for the safety and protection of county residents.
 - 3. Employees will be required to use available leave.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
