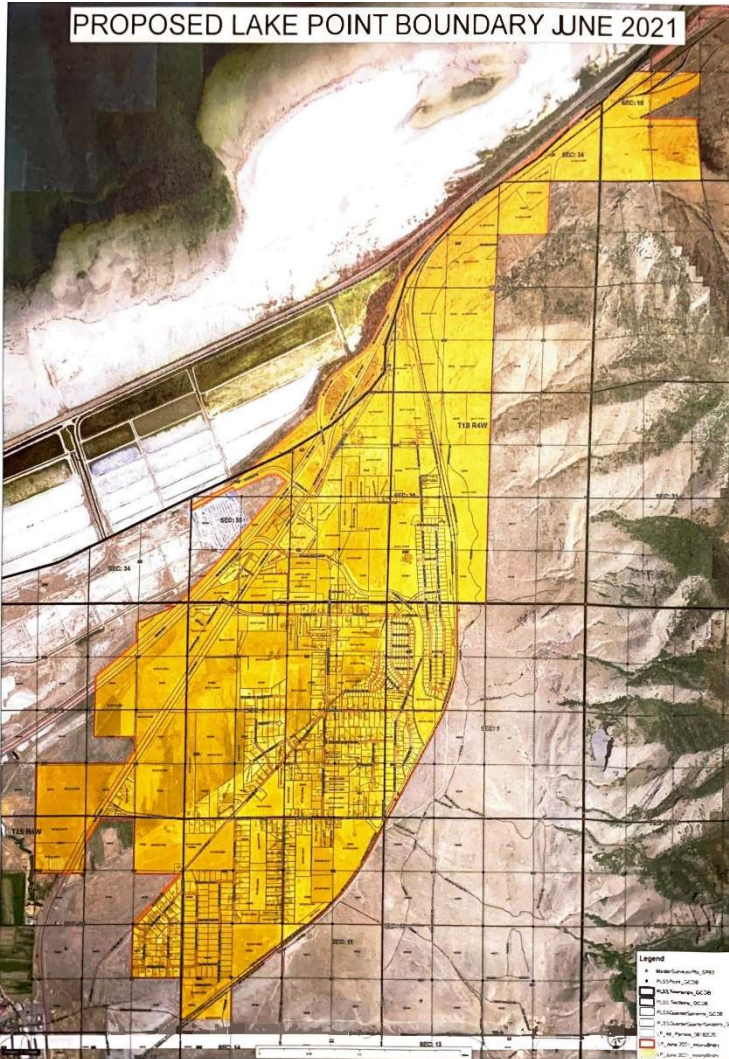


NOTICE OF INCORPORATION ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF LAKE POINT

This proposition will be on the November 2, 2021 General Election. By-Mail Ballots will be sent to all voters within the proposed incorporation area by the 12th of October.

There will be **in-person polling locations** from 7am to 8pm on Election Day at:

- Deseret Peak Complex &
- Tooele County Admin Building

These locations are specifically for the disabled, people who did not receive a ballot in the mail, whose information is incorrect, or other emergencies. However, everyone is welcome. You will receive a paper ballot, exactly like the one you received in the mail. There will be a place you can sit and fill out your ballot and then drop it off in a ballot drop box located on site.

Voted ballots may be returned 1 of 3 ways:

By ballot drop boxes: (by 8pm November 2, 2021)

- Grantsville Box: East of GV City Hall next to utility box
- Stansbury Park Box: 500 E Village Blvd (across from Hug-Hes)
- Tooele City Hall: South of Tooele City Hall, next to utility box
- Tooele County: Alley behind Tooele County Administration Building
