

**TOOELE COUNTY
RESOLUTION 2021-32**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES,
PUBLIC HEALTH EMPLOYEES, HEALTH CARE EMPLOYEES,
HUMAN SERVICES EMPLOYEES, AND SIMILAR EMPLOYEES AS
SUBSTANTIALLY DEDICATED TO MITIGATING OR RESPONDING
TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was passed by Congress and signed by the President on March 11, 2021, to provide financial assistance to governments, individuals, families, and businesses affected by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, ARPA provides money to state, local, and tribal governments navigating the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Treasury has made or will make payments from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to states and eligible units of local government, including Tooele County; and

WHEREAS, ARPA requires that payments from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds only be used for expenditures necessarily incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tooele County Council as follows:

1. Public safety employees, public health employees, health care employees, human services employees, and similar employees are hereby declared to be substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. This resolution shall remain in effect until December 31, 2024, unless repealed earlier by the Tooele County Council.

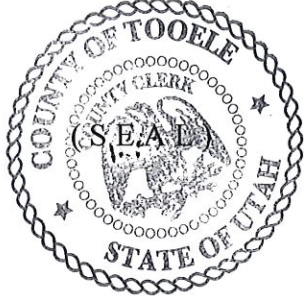
