RESOLUTION 2021-36**

**A RESOLUTION ELIMINATING THE DESERET PEAK ENTERPRISE  
FUND EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, an enterprise fund is a fund used by a local government to financially report an activity primarily funded through the collection of user fees; and

**WHEREAS**, Tooele County has for many years maintained the Deseret Peak enterprise fund; and

**WHEREAS**, user fees are routinely insufficient to primarily support the Deseret Peak enterprise fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the Deseret Peak enterprise fund has rarely if ever shown an annual profit; and

**WHEREAS**, Tooele County has, from year to year, been required to transfer money from its general fund to subsidize the Deseret Peak enterprise fund; and

**WHEREAS**, it does not appear that Deseret Peak will become financially self-sufficient anytime in the near future;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL** that the Deseret Peak enterprise fund is eliminated effective January 1, 2022.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

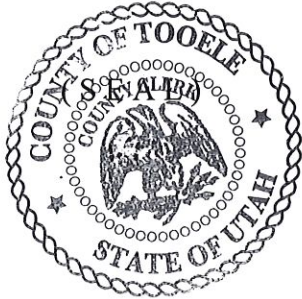
