RESOLUTION 2021-41**

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 2021-01

WHEREAS, the county health officer issued Public Health Order 2021-01 on September 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Public Health Order 2021-01 is an order of constraint as defined in Utah Code Section 26A-1-102(9); and

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Council is the governing body of Tooele County; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Section 26A-1-114(7)(d) states that the relevant county governing body may at any time terminate an order of constraint issued by the local health department by majority vote of the county governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Council has reviewed and considered Public Health Order 2021-01, and has received public input supporting and opposing Public Health Order 2021-01, and has publicly debated the propriety of Public Health Order 2021-01;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL that Public Health Order 2021-01 is hereby terminated.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
