**A RESOLUTION DECLARING SUPPORT FOR AT&T's GRANT
APPLICATION TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF ECONOMIC
OPPORTUNITY**

WHEREAS, AT&T is a telecommunications company doing business in the State of Utah and desires to expand its network capabilities in Tooele County, Utah, more specifically in the Rush Valley/Dugway area along Highway 199; and

WHEREAS, AT&T is pursuing a broadband access grant through the Utah Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires a resolution of support from the Tooele County Council; and

WHEREAS, the request of support from Tooele County does not obligate the County to any financial obligation; and

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Council, in its legislative capacity, has the legal authority to cooperate with private businesses like AT&T for the purposes of providing services that enhance the local economy and quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL that the Tooele County Council affirms its support for AT&T's broadband access grant application to the Utah Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity to provide enhanced telecommunication services in Tooele County, Utah, more specifically in the Rush Valley/Dugway area along Highway 199.
