

**TOOELE COUNTY
RESOLUTION 2022-04**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE CREATION
OF THE HIGH DESERT TRAIL**

WHEREAS, Tooele County includes vast areas of public lands; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County's public lands are often used for off highway vehicle recreation; and

WHEREAS, off highway vehicle recreation fosters tourism and brings visitors to Tooele County and its local communities; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County desires to express its support for the creation of a multi-county OHV trail traversing the State of Utah, passing through Washington County, Iron County, Beaver County, Millard County, Juab County, Tooele County, and Box Elder County, as proposed on the attached map;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL as follows:

1. The Tooele County Council fully supports the creation of an OHV trail known as the "High Desert Trail" which will pass through Tooele County.
2. Tooele County authorizes the use of its existing Class B and Class D roads to facilitate the creation of the High Desert Trail.
3. Tooele County will negotiate in good faith a multi-party memorandum of understanding which will set forth the financial obligations of the various parties and which will establish in more detail trail routes, trail standards, construction and maintenance obligations, publicity, and the acquisition of funding from outside sources.

4. Tooele County will participate in and provide a representative for a steering committee which will be organized to provide oversight and administrative guidance for the development and operation of the High Desert Trail.


EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
