RESOLUTION 2022-17**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING JUNETEENTH NATIONAL FREEDOM
DAY AS A COUNTY LEGAL HOLIDAY**

WHEREAS, the State of Utah has declared that Juneteenth National Freedom Day is a state legal holiday; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County generally observes and adopts state holidays as county holidays; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize and celebrate Juneteenth National Freedom Day as the day that ended slavery in the United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COUNCIL that commencing in 2022, Juneteenth National Freedom Day is adopted as a county legal holiday, to follow the schedule set forth in state law.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

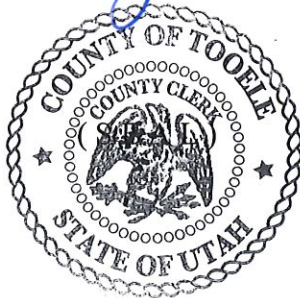
