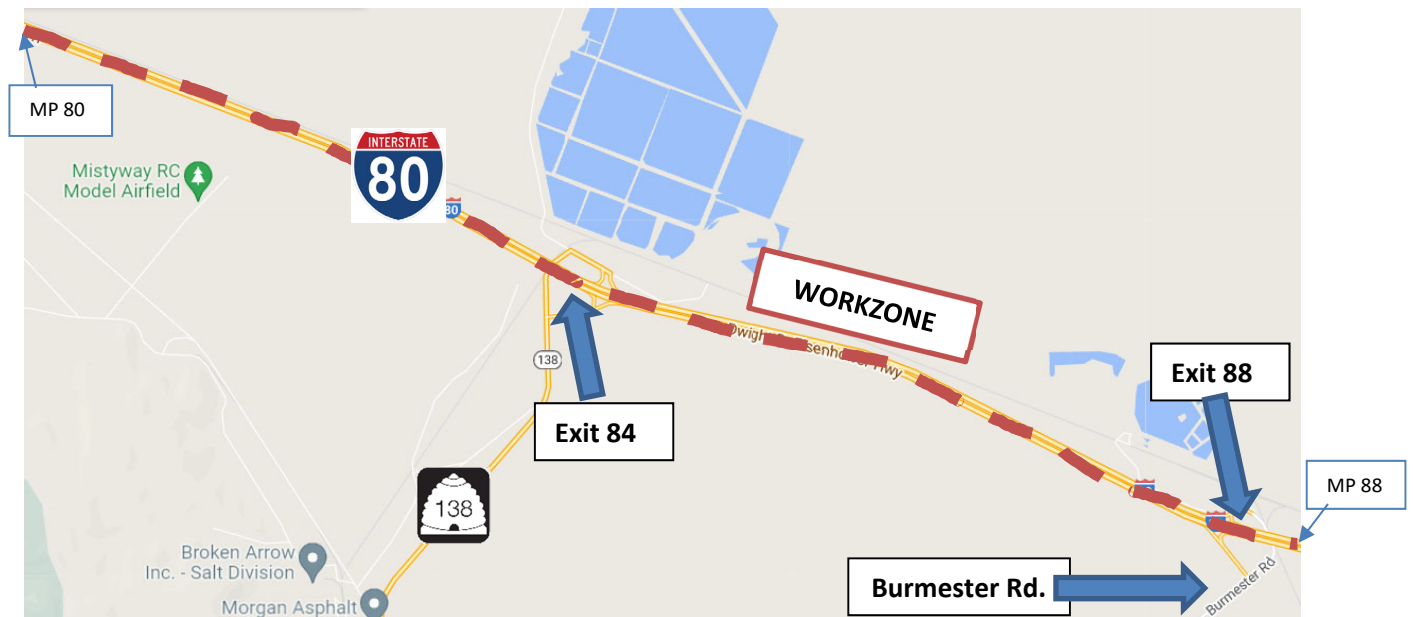


## UDOT to Rehabilitate I-80 Milepost 60-70 & Milepost 80-88

UDOT has a construction project this summer on I-80 that is broken into two segments. Segment 1 consists of I-80 milepost 80 to 88, including ramps at Exit 84 & 88. Segment 2 consists of I-80 milepost 60 to 70, including ramps at Exit 62 & 70.

**Segment 1:** Beginning as early as *Tuesday May 31*, and continuing through *August 2022*, the Utah Department of Transportation will resurface I-80 from milepost 80 to 88. This work will stretch across 8 miles of roadway in the eastbound direction and 8 miles in the westbound direction, including the ramps at Exit 84 & 88. Work on the ramps will take place at night and require full ramp closures. Work on I-80 will take place Monday-Friday from sunrise to sunset, with intermittent Saturday work if needed. During work hours, motorists should anticipate minor travel delays, detours, and traffic reduced to one lane on I-80. Other elements of the project include bridge surface rehabilitation, roadway shoulder treatments, updating signs, and repainting lane striping.



**Segment 2:** Beginning as early as the *middle of July*, and continuing through *October 2022*, the Utah Department of Transportation will resurface I-80 from milepost 60 to 70. This work will stretch across 10 miles of roadway in the eastbound direction and 10 miles in the westbound direction, including the ramps at Exit 62 & 70. Work on the ramps will take place at night and require full ramp closures. Work on I-80 will take place Monday-Friday from sunrise to sunset, with intermittent Saturday work if needed. During work hours, motorists should anticipate minor travel delays, detours, and traffic reduced to one

lane on I-80. Other elements of the project include bridge surface rehabilitation, roadway shoulder treatments, updating signs, and repainting lane striping.



When this work is completed, the life of the pavement in this corridor will be extended, and the driving experience along this highly utilized route will be improved.

**For your safety, as well as the safety of those working in the area, please use extra caution and stay alert while driving through construction zones.
