

**TOOELE COUNTY
RESOLUTION 2022-32**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING CERTAIN
ALTERNATIVES CONTAINED IN THE SOUTHEAST COUNTY FIRE
FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS FINAL REPORT DATED JULY 2022**

WHEREAS, Tooele County retained the Center for Public Safety Management (“CPSM”) to conduct a feasibility analysis to determine the most effective and efficient manner to provide fire services in southeast Tooele County; and

WHEREAS, CPSM completed the analysis and presented its final report to the County Council in June 2022; and

WHEREAS, CPSM’s final report includes four alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has thoroughly reviewed the final report and duly considered and discussed the alternatives;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY
COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The County Council adopts and implements alternative 2 and alternative 4 of the Southeast County Fire Feasibility Analysis final report dated July 2022 as set forth below.

2. Alternative 2 is adopted and shall be implemented as follows:

(a) the Human Resources Department shall prepare a job description for the position of Countywide Fire Services Director within the Emergency Management Department;

(b) the Human Resources Department shall move the positions for the fire warden and staff from the Sheriff’s Office to the Emergency Management Department;

(c) the County Manager shall appoint a Countywide Fire Services Director;

(d) the Countywide Fire Services Director shall conduct a comprehensive review of all existing fire protection and hazardous materials service agreements, shall prepare new

proposed agreements, and shall submit the new agreements to the County Council for review no later than the second County Council meeting in September 2022;

(e) the Countywide Fire Services Director shall apply for a FY2022 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant; and


(f) the Countywide Fire Services Director, the County Manager, and the County Auditor shall together prepare and submit to the County Council, as soon as possible, a plan to fund the construction of a fire facility in South Rim.

3. Alternative 4 is adopted and shall be implemented as follows: the Community Development Department shall immediately begin to require the installation of automatic fire sprinkling systems in all new structures pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Section 15a-5-203.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
