ORDINANCE 2023-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-17-3, ADOPTION OF
INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, OF CHAPTER 17, MISCELLANEOUS
PROVISIONS, OF TITLE 6, PUBLIC SAFETY, OF THE TOOELE
COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, current Section 6-17-3 adopts the International Fire Code and Appendices B, C and D; and

WHEREAS, it is expedient that the county also adopt Appendices F and H;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – SECTION AMENDED. Section 6-17-3, *Adoption of International Fire Code*, of Chapter 17, *Miscellaneous Provisions*, of Title 6, *Public Safety*, of the Tooele County Code is hereby amended to read as attached hereto, which attachment is, by this reference, made a part hereof.

SECTION II – REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III – EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.

Chapter 17: Miscellaneous Provisions

6-17-3. Adoption of International Fire Code.
