Whereas RECOVERY can and does happen, and all Tooele County citizens should know that support and help is available regardless of any individual's situation; and

Whereas, CREATING A COMMUNITY of informed and caring individuals that foster an environment where everyone feels comfortable reaching out for the support they deserve is crucial to end the stigma around mental health, and

Whereas ACCESS to support and ending the stigma is of paramount importance, and

Whereas Tooele County wishes to ENHANCE PUBLIC AWARENESS of mental health, now, and in the future, therefore, be it

Resolved that the Tooele County Council, thereof concurring, hereby recognizes May 2023 as Mental Health Awareness Month with specific activities planned for the week of May 22-26, 2023, to enhance public awareness of mental health, to help end the stigma, and enrich the lives of all Tooele County citizens.
