This equipment will enable us to perform efficient rope rescues and ensure the safety of our firefighters during these high-risk opera ons.

## Project Goals:

Improve our capabili es to conduct rope rescue in dangerous terrain across Tooele County. Enhance the safety of our firefighters and community members during rescue opera ons. Decrease response mes to incidents involving ver cal/high-angle and low-angle rescues. Provide ongoing training to maintain a high level of proficiency in rope rescue techniques.

Securing the proposed funds would allow us to further our ambitions to become Tooele County's rope rescue team and reduce the risk in our vast county. Currently, Tooele County does not have a rope rescue team or a rope access team. Rope access teams respond to similar situations but work with vertical situations like windmills, towers, cranes, and tall buildings. Rope access teams have the ability to ascend or descend to individuals needing rescue.

This skillset and equipment has always been needed in this county. As Tooele County grows in size the need for this program only increases. We need the capability to safely respond to these situations. With this award, our program can gain the much needed equipment to finally make our team response ready and allow us to further our training with our own equipment.
